

RING SIZE GUIDE

To ensure the ring sizes are displayed correctly, please check that this printout is to scale. Print this guide at **100%** and use a ruler to verify that it measures exactly **40 millimeters**.




How to determine your ring size:

1. Find a ring that fits you perfectly.
2. Place the ring on this sheet - its inner diameter should match the diameter of one of the circles.
3. Alternatively, use a caliper or ruler to measure the inner diameter of your ring and find the corresponding size.
 - For example, if your ring's inner diameter is 16.6 mm, your ring size is 52.
 - If your measurement falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.

Tips for accurate sizing:

- Measure your ring size at room temperature.
- Finger sizes tend to be smaller in winter (cold fingers) and larger in summer (warm fingers).
- The ring design may affect the fit:
 - Wider rings may require a larger size.
 - Stacking multiple rings on the same finger may also require a larger size.
 - If you have wider knuckles, consider going up a size for a more comfortable fit.
